TENANTS TO HAVE A SAY ON PLANNING PROCESS

Whitefriars Housing Group tenants are being invited to have a say on the future of the Hillside Meadway area of the city during a customer involvement day.

The day will give residents a chance to see how the area might look after redevelopment and to put their views forward on aspects of the scheme.

Architects' impressions and outline plans will be on display to give residents an insight into how the redevelopment will unfold.

The day will bring to conclusion a two-month consultation process, which has seen Whitefriars working with a panel of residents to ensure the best outcome for all involved in the redevelopment.

Whitefriars North Regional Manager Kevin Roach said: “The involvement day presents residents and people interested in the redevelopment with an opportunity to input their ideas into how the area should look. This brings to an end the extensive consultation process we have carried out and allows us to take the development another step forward.”

Whitefriars is expecting to submit its formal planning application at the end of the month.
